2. RESULT OF TRIAL IN GENERAL COURT-MARTIAL.

Private _____, Infantry, 97th Infantry Division, was tried by a general court-martial at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri, on 28 June 1944 for AWOL from 7 March to 20 May 1944, and for wrongful taking of an Army truck at Waynesville, Missouri, on 5 March 1944. He was found guilty and sentenced to be dishonorably discharged the service, to forfeit all pay and allowances due or to become due, and to be confined at hard labor for 10 years.

4. VOTING IN AUGUST STATE PRIMARY ELECTIONS IN THE STATES OF ARKANSAS, KANSAS, KENTUCKY, MISSISSIPPI, MISSOURI, NEW YORK, SOUTH CAROLINA, TENNESSEE, TEXAS, UTAH, VERMONT, VIRGINIA, AND WISCONSIN.

a. Military personnel having voting residences in the above states (all of which will hold primary elections in August) may apply for ballots by forwarding postcard WD AGO Form 560, addressed to the Secretary of State of each named state at the State capital thereof. Such application should be made at the earliest possible date.

b. Full information and postcard applications may be obtained from Unit Soldier Voting Officers.

c. Further information on the state primaries to be held in September and October will be furnished in the Daily Bulletin from time to time. (DSVO)

5. NOTICE "TEX" TO UNIT SOLDIER VOTING OFFICERS.

TEX from The Adjutant General to Hq Seventh Service Command, dated 19 Jun 44 is as follows:

"ARMY NOT REPEAT NOT AUTHORIZED TO DO ANY OVER-PRINTING ON POST CARD APPLICATIONS FOR STATE ABSENTEE BALLOTS (WD AGO FORM 560 AND US WBC FORM 1) OR ON ANY OTHER SOLDIER VOTING FORM. ANY CHANGES, ADDITIONS OR ENTRIES ON WD AGO FORM 560 OR ON ANY OTHER SOLDIER VOTING FORM REQUIRED BY CIRCULAR 155, WD, 44 AND OTHER WD INSTRUCTIONS SHOULD BE MADE BY INDIVIDUAL USING FORM UNLESS SPECIFICALLY DIRECTED OTHERWISE BY WAR DEPARTMENT. IN EVENT ANY SUCH OVER-PRINTING HAS BEEN DONE, FORMS INVOLVED WILL BE WITHDRAWN AND NOT REPEAT NOT USED. DESIRED ALL INSTALLATIONS INCLUDING CLASS III AND IV INSTALLATIONS WITHIN GEOGRAPHICAL LIMITS YOUR SERVICE COMMAND BE SO INFORMED END"
