1. GENERAL ELECTION IN MAINE.

The Maine general election for all public offices except President and Vice-President will be held 11 September 1944. All soldiers having voting residences in Maine who desire to vote in the 11 September 1944 general election should forward an application for a state absentee ballot at the earliest possible date. Application may be made by postcard, using either WD AGO Form 560 or USWDC Form No. 1. (DSVO)

2. VOTING IN SEPTEMBER AND OCTOBER STATE PRIMARY ELECTIONS IN THE STATES OF COLORADO, LOUISIANA, AND NEVADA.

a. The states of Colorado, Louisiana, and Nevada, hold primary elections in September. Louisiana holds a second primary in October. Military personnel having voting residence in the above-named states may apply for primary election ballots by forwarding postcard WD AGO Form 560, addressed to the Secretary of State of the state of their residence, at the proper state capitol. Such application should be made at the earliest possible date.

b. Full information and postcard applications may be obtained from Unit Soldier Voting Officers, or from the Division Soldier Voting Officer (Phone 25), or information only may be obtained from Cir. 221, WD, 3 June 1944. (DSVO)

3. NOTICE TO SOLDIER VOTING OFFICERS.

Attention of all Soldier Voting Officers in the Division is directed to WD Cir. 302, 17 Jul 44, which contains certain changes to WD Soldier Voting Poster No. 2. All posters should be amended immediately in accordance therewith. (DSVO)

4. NOTICE TO UNIT PERSONNEL OFFICERS; AND ALL SOLDIER VOTING OFFICERS.

a. Distribution of applications for absentee ballots, USWDC Form No. 1; to each soldier in the Division will be made on Tuesday, 22 August 1944. Records will be kept showing distribution of copies of USWDC Form No. 1 to each soldier in the Division.

b. Revised list of all Soldier Voting Officers in the Division, including names of Regimental, Battalion, and Company Soldier Voting Officers, will be submitted to the Division Soldier Voting Officer, in the Division Judge Advocate's Office, Building 624, by Friday, 11 August 1944. (DSVO)
